## Medication At Camp

The Education Code, which allows students to take medication at school, also applies while students are at camp. The same requirements must be met (see form on back for details). In some instances children are allowed to keep their medication on their person and self administer. This is particularly appropriate for students with asthma, who should have their inhalers, such as Albuterol, on their person especially during long hikes and other outings. If you want your child to take medication while at camp, you must complete the Medication Consent form on the back. A separate form is required for each medication. If you already have a completed Medication Consent Form on file at your school for medication which will be needed at camp, ask the school secretary to make a copy for camp use. Remember to specify if you wish your child to be allowed to have medication on his/her person.
